We thank you for your prayers and support during these past 3 months. We want to share with you our news of what God has been doing in ICM in these recent months through your prayers and love which we have received.

Outreach in Jordan streets

We had 3 open air outreaches at the Night Market Streets and at Jordan parks. The young-adult group went out with gospel dramas, dances, testimonies, gospel tracts which attracted the crowd to whom they shared the gospel. This has been an opportunity for our young adult to witness Jesus, the Christ as well as practice what they learn at the Youth Fellowship. We saw God move as we stepped out. God brought salvation on people who believed in him.

Taste of Grace

Our new project Taste of Grace offered our first 3 month Basic Commercial Cookery course to 6 people from different ethnic groups. Our main purpose to initiate this course was to train the people in cooking skills as well as share the gospel of Jesus to them. Our staff Kaushic



and Dhan Kumari planned the whole curriculum and taught the students. 5 graduated out of 6. During the course, we had time of sharing and praying for one another every day. By the end of the course, most of the students said that they felt like a family. One Muslim lady shared that she enjoyed the prayer time they had and came to know more about Jesus during the course. Please pray for the staff as they continue to reach out to them as well as for the students that they will get good jobs.

Kids during Summer

This year's summer programme for children was the most extensive ever run by Inner City Ministries and the children were treated to activities, educational games and vacation Bible school for over six weeks. Our children have little to do in the summer vacation, so our summer programs provide opportunities for them to gain new skills, learn bible stories in exciting ways and have fun together with other children. All our programs were funded by generous donations from outside and were run by a very large number of volunteers from Hong Kong and the USA. Overall over 80 children took part and we would like to take this opportunity to thank all our donors and supporters and especially - Hong Kong University students and the team from OMF for great outdoor activities; Clearwater Bay Baptist Church, Brentwood Baptist Church (USA) and Union Church for amazing Vacation Bible Schools; Island Evangelical Community Church and youth services who led three weeks

of great activities in August. Our children have grown more than they realize through these wonderful gifts of time, skill and money. Thank you.

Missions in Nepal

Our staff Ebson and Tryfina along with 6 other people went to north west part of Nepal with an aim to share the gospel and provide Mini Discipleship Trainings (DTS). We had a 3 day Mini DTS for the youths in Nepalgunj. Over 120 youths finished this training and went to the streets to do an open air outreach. Over 15 people gave their lives to Jesus during the outreach. Many youths testified that they were afraid of sharing the gospel at first but was surprised to see God use them as they spoke out.

After Nepalgunj, we went to the unreached, unevangelized part of Nepal further north.



The place name is Jumla. We had been praying for 2 years that God would open up a way for us to share gospel in that land as well as provide some medical facilities. This year with full support of prayer and financial blessing we were able to accomplish this vision. Our team helped the villagers in providing basic information on preventing sickness. They cleaned the wounds and cuts of people and applied medicine. We also distributed some medicine to the sick. The villagers were given a toothbrush and toothpaste

for every house members. We want to thank all who prayed for and sent us there. Deep thanks to Dr. Robert Ho, Andrew, Jemi, Belita and other anonymous friends for their financial contribution which has allowed us to do the work of God in completion.

Himalayan Global 2011 (HIM GLO 2011)

We had a privilege of being a part of Him Glo 2011 in the Chinese YMCA, Wu Kwai Sha during 14th-16th Aug. More than 500 Nepalese from around the globe had gathered to focus on sharing the Gospel both cross culturally and worldwide. Inner City Ministries staff Dhan and Caroline were involved fully in co-planning the conference, Ebson and Tryfina in worship/choir leading in partnership with the Nepali Christian Youth. It was a fruitful time for us to be filled from God and hear the heart of God for missions once again.



Pastor Dr. Robert from Kalimpong who has been serving as a missionary in Nepal for many years said, “ In the missions that God has called us into, He does not call us to be busy and sweat. Sweat is not from God. It was used as a curse to labour in Genesis. But He has called us to rest in Him: hear from Him and only do what He says...” This was inspiring to all of us to chase after what God has for us.
